Flame of Friendship

In the run up to the 2024 Paris Olympic and Paralympic games, 62 Coventry primary, secondary and special educational needs schools will be participating in a torch relay, the Flame of Friendship, leaving Coventry Cathedral on Thursday 22nd February and finishing on the University of

Warwick campus on Monday 8th July. At the Finale on Monday 8th, 1000+ Coventry pupils and teachers will line the road on the University of Warwick campus and join a procession as the torch passes by, making its way along the final relay leg to Butterworth Hall at the Warwick Arts Centre, pausing in the Piazza where members of the Royal Opera House will lead the participants in an Olympic themed dance. On Friday, we will be welcoming 'The Flame of Friendship' to Wyken Croft. It will be delivered by a local primary school and we have lots of exciting things planned to celebrate this special occasion with the children on Friday. The torch will then make its way around the school and all children will be able to see it. Our job is then to deliver it to another local school on Monday 29th April. This is an amazing, historical opportunity and we are really looking forward to it.
